HOW?

By empowering authorities and key actors in local self-government units to promote dialogue, civic engagement, and stronger social structures and services. Through meaningful exchanges between youth and community leaders, the initiative strengthens trust in local institutions, encourages collaboration, and equips young women and men to build cross-community and inter-entity connections, as a foundation for a shared future.

WHAT HAVE WE ACHIEVED SO FAR (until January 2025)?

Facilitated 21 dialogues, engaging 302 citizens in meaningful discussions to foster social cohesion and mutual understanding.

Mobilized 18 UN Community Volunteers, strengthening community-level engagement and support.

Implemented 548 initiatives, including dialogues, workshops, training/mentoring sessions, interschool and intercommunity visits, fairs, festivals, youth club formations, psychotherapy sessions, and meetings with government and CSO representatives, impacting diverse groups across the country.

Completed 7 community social work projects in Bosanski Petrovac, Ključ, and Livno, directly benefiting local citizens and promoting resilience.

Launched 9 reconstruction projects, supporting recovery and long-term development in affected communities.
