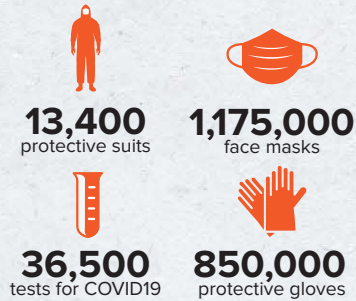


SUPPORT THE HEALTH SYSTEMS TO RESPOND TO COVID-19

ADDRESSING THE SOCIO-ECONOMIC IMPACTS OF COVID-19

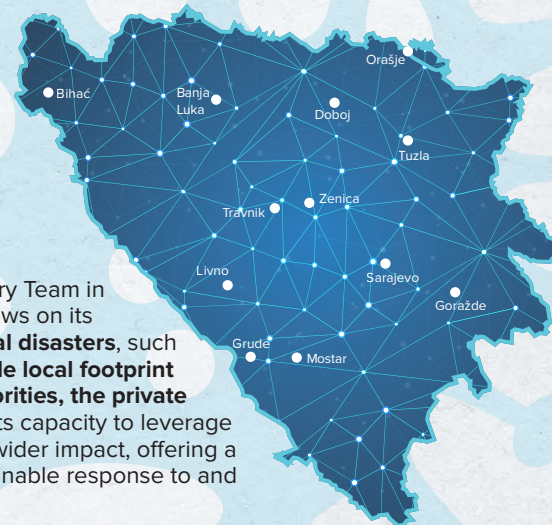

As part of the United Nations Country Team in Bosnia and Herzegovina, **UNDP** draws on its **experience of responding to natural disasters**, such as the floods in 2014, its **countrywide local footprint and strong partnerships with authorities, the private sector and civil society**, as well as its capacity to leverage innovation and digital solutions for wider impact, offering a people-centred, inclusive and sustainable response to and recovery from the COVID-19 crisis.

UNDP deploys technology and digital solutions to support authorities deliver **more effective, data-based and coordinated inter-institutional COVID-19 crisis monitoring, management and response**.



We tap into the **collective intelligence and engage local talent** to address the impact of COVID-19: **109 proposals** were received during the digital 'ideathon #covIDEJA' launched with BitAlliance and twenty other partners.



We support the multi-tier cross-institutional **Coordination Body of Bosnia and Herzegovina for Protection and Rescue** to ensure timely vertical and horizontal communication and respond effectively to the crisis.
