WHAT HAVE WE ACHIEVED SO FAR (until January 2025)?

Empowered educators across Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Western Balkans to enhance digital safety and critical thinking among students, fostering resilience in the digital age.

Integrated peacebuilding concepts into nine academic subjects at the Universities of Banja Luka and Bihać, embedding peacebuilding principles into higher education.

Facilitated the adoption of the Youth Strategy by the Sarajevo Canton Government, driving youth development and active engagement in decision-making processes.

Advanced media narratives on peacebuilding through a collaboration with Al-Jazeera Balkans, available on the University of Sarajevo's e-learning platform for broader use.

Organized inclusive sports events in partnership with the Special Olympics and supported by the Ministry of Civil Affairs of BiH, ensuring sustainability and inclusivity for years to come.

Enhanced media and information literacy, along with critical thinking skills among youth and young journalists, to foster the creation and promotion of constructive, inclusive, and gender-sensitive narratives.
