#### WHAT ARE WE TRYING TO ACHIEVE?

Transform how youth perceive the past conflict, combat historical revisionism, enhance understanding of the war, emphasize the importance of fact-based knowledge, and address genocide denial.

### HOW?

By developing a comprehensive study program for final-year secondary school students and teachers, ensuring the fact-based open source of information for educational and informational purposes, organizing study visits, and involving youth in designing a document to advocate for a youth-oriented transitional justice strategy.
