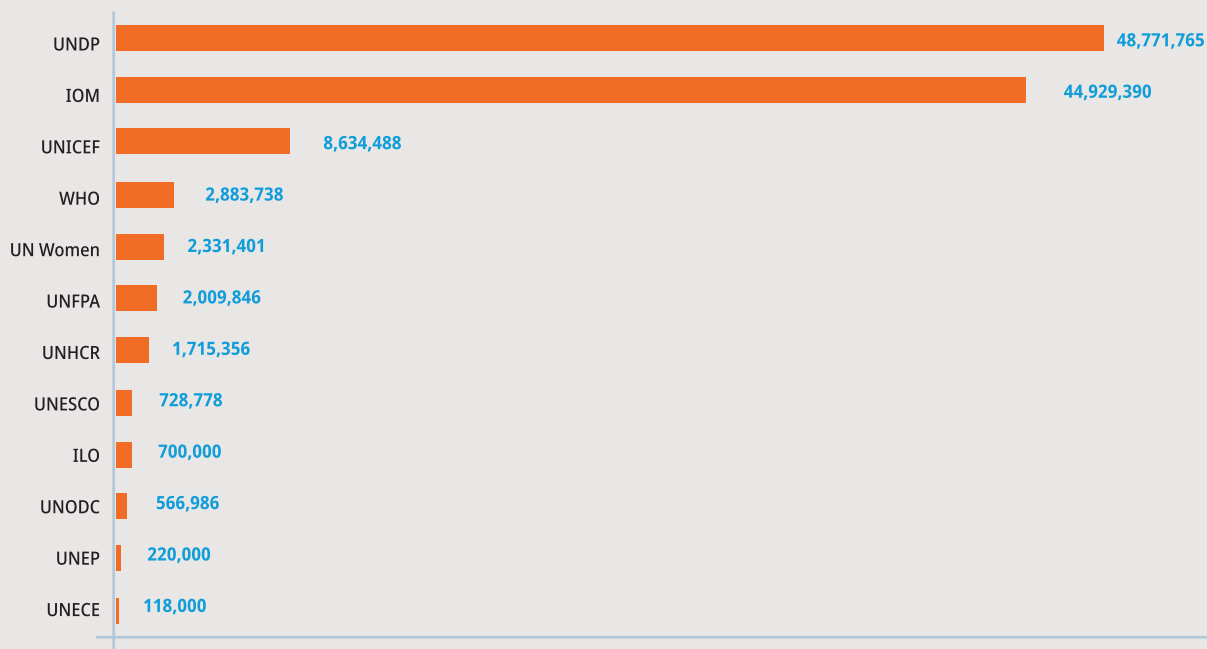


Planned budget for 2020:

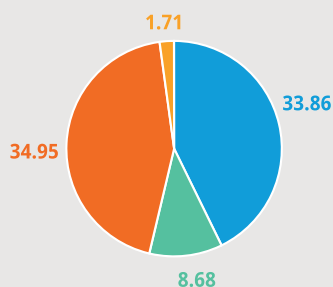


Expenditures 2020:
