The goal is to foster a culture of creativity, reflection on the past, and constructive dialogue, ultimately creating a lasting impact through innovative peace education practices.

INVESTMENT: USD 997,000	The project consists of two key components: The first, Creative Peacebuilders, involves training and mentoring over 100 youth (aged 15-29) from 20 municipalities in creative and storytelling practices, enabling them to develop museum collections, produce exhibitions, and receive grants to implement these exhibitions in their local communities. The second component, Peace Education, focuses on training and mentoring more than 240 teachers and peer-to-peer educators from 30 municipalities, equipping them to implement innovative peace education activities in schools, primarily through object-based learning approaches.
