**Completed a comprehensive WPS assessment,** providing valuable insights into WPS implementation and key human security concerns to guide future initiatives in BiH.

**Identified 17 target local communities,** and initiated community dialogues, laying the groundwork for impactful, context-driven interventions.

**Enhanced healthcare capacity** by training over 100 professionals to deliver inclusive, survivor-centered services, significantly improving care for those affected by conflict.

**Conducting two parallel mapping processes** in the creative industry to identify key areas for intervention and growth.

**Running a mentoring progra**m for journalism students, fostering the next generation of peacebuilders and advocates.

**Conducting an evaluability assessment,** ensuring that our efforts are measurable, sustainable, and impactful.
